

## History

- 1964 The original Salem site was purchased and constructed on 10 acres by Reliance Universal. It consisted of one 10,000 sq/ft concrete building to provide coatings to the Georgia Pacific business in the Pacific Northwest.
- 1972 The site expanded by adding additional production and warehouse buildings to the existing structure, with a new building adding a laboratory and administration offices.
- 1981 The Tyler Corporation purchased Reliance Universal operating under the Reliance Universal name and continued to expand business in the flat line, primer, and cabinetry industries. GP, Schuler, Diamond Cabinets, Vanport, Masonite, States Ind were some of our customers. Some of these companies are still partnered with us today.
- 1989 Akzo purchased the Reliance
  Universal division from The Tyler
  Corporation creating Akzo Reliance.
  Site improvements were an attached finished goods warehouse, tank farm and drum storage pad.
- 1995 Incorporated Fuller O'brien business.
- 1998 Incorporated the Akzonobel Langley site business.
- 2000 Added gallon high speed dispersers, and nine 6000 gallon storage tanks to meet the high demand of the bulk primer, sealer and topcoat business.
- **2001** Incorporated the Akzonobel Orange Site business.
- **2008** Incorporated the Chemcraft Chico Site business.
- 2023 The site is the only AkzoNobel factory in the West. It produces coatings primarily for the building products industry.
