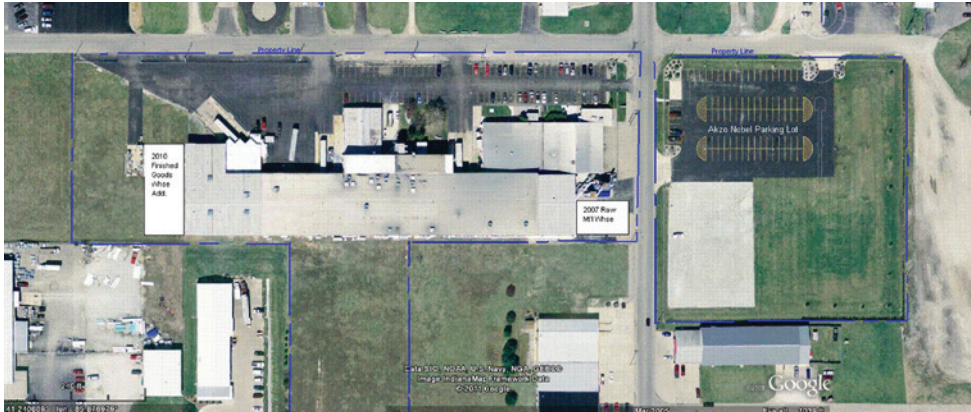

- 1960** Powder Coating Production Begins in Warsaw IN
- 1971** Phillip Morris Industrial Acquires Armstrong Products
- 1982** Morton Company Acquires Armstrong from Philip Morris Industrial
- 1999** Rohm and Hass Acquires Morton
- 2009** Dow Chemical acquires Rohm and Hass
- 2010** AkzoNobel acquires all powder coating facilities from Dow Chemical
