Building H - Built in 1936 / utilized for Production Manufacturing

Buildings I, J, K and O - Built between 1956 – 1960 / Administration

Buildings M and N - Built in 1965 and 1967 utilized for Warehousing

Buildings P, Q and S - Built in 1972 – 1976 designated as the new Production Manufacturing Area

Building H - Designated for Maintenance & R&D

Building T - Built in 1994 / Receiving, QC Lab and Planning

2005 demolished building A which was built around early 1900s
